Dear Parents,

In 2002 Congress passed legislation that requires high schools to provide military recruiters, upon request, access to secondary school students and directory information on those students. Both the *No Child Left Behind Act of 2001* and the *National Defense Authorization Act of 2002* reflect these requirements. In accordance with those Acts, military recruiters are entitled to receive the name, address, and telephone listing of juniors and seniors in high school. This directory information will be used specifically for armed services recruiting purposes and for informing students of scholarship opportunities.

The *Family Educational Rights and Privacy Act* allows the distribution of general directory information without your written consent. <u>However, if you do not want New Haven Public Schools to disclose directory information from your child's education records without your prior written consent, you must notify the school district in writing.</u>

Below you will find a form, which you may use to notify New Haven Public Schools that you <u>do not</u> want directory information for your child disclosed to military recruiters. Please return form no later than <u>Friday, September 27, 2019</u>.
