

Business and Non-Instructional Operations

Transportation

The Board of Education shall provide transportation for students in accordance with applicable law. The Superintendent of Schools shall administer the operation so as to:

1. Provide for maximum safety of students;
2. Supplement and reinforce desirable student behavior patterns;
3. Assist handicapped students accordingly; and
4. Enrich the instructional program through carefully planned field trips as recommended by the staff.

Transportation by private carrier may be provided whenever such practice is more economical than using school district-owned facilities. Parents may be reimbursed for transportation of eligible students whenever such practice is more economical or convenient. All drivers will be subject to the drug and alcohol policy for employees of the New Haven Public Schools.
