The Committee <u>TABLED</u> Amendment #1 to the Agreement by and between the New Haven Board of Education and Go To Commercial Cleaning Services, LLC, 118 Kendall St., New Haven, CT for Facilities Maintenance, Custodial Management and Energy Management increasing the compensation amount from \$1,470,030.63 by \$117,920.00 to \$1,587,950.63 for additional scope of services to cover duties from retired district supervisor for FY 2019-20.

Committee members expressed concerns that the information provided did not clearly explain potential cost savings created by eliminating the position of a retired district supervisor and increasing funding to the contractor for the service. Committee members requested additional information in the comparison chart contained in the amendment.

DISCUSSION

- F&O Memo Revision: Mr. Wilcox recommended enhancing the memo used to present Agreements and Contracts. The recommended changes add clarifying questions to aid the Board during review. The committee discussed process for approving the new memo. Ms. DeMaio explained that the current memo was originally developed by a former CFO and was not approved by the Board of Education. Committee members concurred that Board approval was not necessary for the revision, but asked that it be included in the board packet for the November 25, 2019 Board of Education meeting. Ms. DeMaio was asked to update the draft.
- Financial Report: Ms. Juanita Mazyck reported that total expenditures incurred through October 31, 2019 are \$32.7 million or 17.37% of the adopted budget. She reported a General Fund deficit of \$8,414,347. Ms. Linda Hannans reported on grant funding to date. Total grant expenditures incurred through October 31, 2019 are \$9.4 million or 22% of the grants awarded to date. Ms. Hannans explained

that grant award timing is not in sync with the fiscal year requiring reimbursement for expenses previously incurred. A discussion ensued.

■ **Budget Mitigation**: Dr. Tracey reported that staff were notified of a freeze on general fund spending. She explained that allowances will be made on a case by case situation if the funding is necessary for student service. Mr. Philip Penn, the new Chief Financial Officer, explained that he will be reviewing all positions and funding to determine areas for mitigation.
