Strategic Problem of Practice:

At each grade level, large percentages of New Haven Public School students are not properly prepared to transition to the following grade successfully, as evidenced by low performance on summative assessments and state assessments. There is a need for clearly defined expectations, progress monitoring and adjustments in instruction as students engage with content through the academic year to ensure more students are on track, particularly students of color, students from low income homes, students with disabilities and English Learners."
