Abstract will be presented to the finance committee and Board at the end of August.
iii. School In-Person Reopening Update – Dr. Paul Whyte	Safe return to in-person instruction and continuity of services plan is still platformed. This will be review and updated every six month. Plans will be publicly available by June 23, 2021. There is continuity of mask wearing, hand washing, sanitizing, limited access of person entering buildings, cleaning protocols, video conference meetings and contact tracing. Twelve schools are available for COVID-19 diagnostic testing as well as Vaccination clinics for students. Bus Safety practices continues.
