

SECTION C - PROJECT SPECIFICS-DETAILED

Repairs to Pool as outlined in attached specs. Patch exterior of pool in basement using proper materials to adhere to existing walls. Please provide a submittal of the product you propose to use. See specification provided by IES.

A new liner will be installed in the interior of the pool as detailed in the specifications below.

CONTE POOL REPAIR SPECIFICATION Exterior of Pool



On the exterior side of the pool walls, all loosen concrete shall be removed. Rust on exposed reinforcing steel shall be removed with steel wool brush. Upon cleaning the surfaces on exposed reinforcing steel, coat them with Sika Armatec-110 Epocem. Patch all removed concrete area with Sikatop-123 Plus. The concrete surfaces shall be prepared as required prior to patching. Contractor shall also check the concrete wall from this side by sounding with handheld hammer. Remove and replace delaminated concrete as required.

All manufactured products may be replaced with approved equivalent. Contractor shall submit product details for engineer's review. All manufactured products shall be installed strictly according to manufacturer's instructions.

CONTE POOL REPAIRD SPECIFICATION Interior of Pool

POOL DIMENSIONS 60ft x 49ft

QT 22 scupper drains Qt 20 return inlets Qt 6 Rope hooks Qt 3 18x18 main drain sumps

Gutter:

- -15.5" wide
- 8.5" vertical back wall

1. PREPARATION

- Isolate and pressure test all pool piping
 - Scuppers and lines back to balance tank
 - Filtered water return line and inlets
 - Main drain line back to balance tank
- Acid wash and sound pool for hollow spots

2. PIPING REPAIRS

- Repair any piping leaks as needed

3. DEMOLITION

- Remove tile from hollow sections of pool surface
- Prep location for inset 6x6 tile depth marker on vertical wall of gutter (QT 10)
- Removal of rope hooks and core vertical gutter lip for new plastic rope hooks (QT-6)
- Saw cut chip and removal of tile and set bed around existing scupper drains approximately 6"x12" section (OT 22)
- Saw cut chip and removal of tile and set bed around existing filtered water return inlets approximately 6"x6" section (QT 20)
- Saw cut chip and removal of tile and set bed around existing mains drains approximately 3" around entire perimeter section (QT 3)
- Prep all penetrations for hydroactive grout injection
- Grind entire gutter surface wrapping 2" on to the deck and 6" down pool wall to create proper profile for new epoxy resin finish

4. ROPE ANCHORS INSTALLATION

- Set new PVC rope anchors in cores with SIKATOP 123 PLUS

5. HOLLOW SPOT PATCH

- Clean any exposed rebar and coat with SIKA ARMATEC- 110 EPOCEM
- Patch with SIKATOP 123 PLUS

6. PENITRATION FITTING REPAIR

- Inject Hydrofilic hidroactive polyurethane grout to seal all fittings and main drains (OT 45)
- Clean any exposed rebar and coat with SIKA ARMATEC- 110 EPOCEM (QT 45)
- Patch around fittings with SIKATOP 123 PLUS

7. GUTTER FINISHING

GUTTER SURACE INCLUDES ENTIRE GUTTER 2" ONTO DECK AND 6" DOWN POOL WALL AT ENTIRE POOL PERIMETER

- Apply SIKA 265 WATERPROOF EPOXY COATING to entire gutter surface
- Apply SIKA 216 COVE RESIN and trowel with mixed color quartz epoxy mortar
- Apply additional coat of SIKA 216 and broadcast quartz with miked color flake
- Seal with 2 coats of SIKA 510 POLYASPARTIC TOP COAT

8 LINING SYSTEM

- Acid wash pool
- Clean and disinfect pool
- Install new Ebtol 60 ml PVC membrane, terminating at start of gutter (NO LINES)
- PVC membrane ladder bumper blocks
- Return fitting termination fitting
- Main drain termination fitting
- All necessary hardware, adhesive, termination strips, anchors
- 60 mil PVC membrane must carrie a 15 year warranty

9 VGB COMPLIANCE

- Update main drain covers for VGB compliance

CONTE SCHOOL POOL SUFACE RENOVATION PROJECT INCLUDES: -

- -Hollow spot removal and patching
- -Prep and install new water line depth marker tiles on gutter face Qt 8
- -Remove and replace rope anchors Qt 6
- -Prep, seal, and patch all scupper penetrations Qt 22
- -Prep seal, and patch all return inlets Qt 20
- -Prep, seal, and patch main drains Ot 3
- -Prep entire gutter for polyaspartic epoxy coating
- -Urethane injection as needed for scuppers and inlets
- -Apply polyaspartic epoxy finish to gutter system
- -Acid wash pool surface –
- -Sanitize pool surface
- -Prep and install an Ebtol 60mill PVC membrane to pool floors and walls with termination bar below gutter
- -Install termination fittings around filtered water return inlets and main drains -
- -Update main drains per the VGB safety act –
- -Replace the perimeter piping isolation valve on existing piping to remain
- -Qt 1 3" scupper isolation valve
- -Qt 2 3" filtered water return trance isolation valves
- -Ot 1 4" filtered water trunk isolation valve
- -Qt 2 6" main drain isolation valves
- -Replace related hardware
