- IV. Deficiency: Active Supervision
 - > October 8, 2020 Review Date
 - ➤ Mr. Wilcox will attend with leadership team
 - Virtual meeting
 - Draft action plan was reviewed
- V. COVID-19 One Time Funds
 - ➤ MERF 13 have been installed at Mayo
 - ➤ District contracting with engineer firm to look at mechanics of buildings
 - Possible use: extra bus monitors
- VI. ChildPlus Database
 - Leadership training took place the week of July 26, 2020
 - > Teacher and Family Service Worker training scheduled for week of August 31, 2020
- VII. Finance: no report generated
 - Discussion on program fiscal officer that has been named. Awaiting her acceptance of position.
 - > MUNIS system is currently down and unable to generate reports
- VIII. Health: Area of Non-compliance
 - ➤ Generated from Focus Area 1 review
 - ➤ 16 children in program with overdue physicals but the school closing due to covid-19 played a role in the physicals not being completed.
 - ➤ Hearing and vision screenings were not completed on all children
 - ➤ Health specialist will be writing an action plan and timeline for completion of screenings for the 2020-2021 school year
 - December 1, 2020 is the virtual review with Region One Office
 - ➤ Pamela Augustine-Jefferson is meeting with Jenn Vazquez to discuss nursing support of Head Start children when they return in November.
