Minutes

- 1. Reviewed Minutes from August 31, 2020 meeting
- 2. There was no discussion for old or new business
- 3. The discussion for the Pandemic Policy was brief. The team felt more work needed to be done in order to interpret the narrative language within the policy. A suggestion of corresponding checklists was discussed and an initial discussion was had to the elements of such checklist and a follow up would be made moving forward
- 4. Dr. Jackson stated the SRO Committee was on its way to meeting and that she would as Dr. Torre who is the committee chair to be a part of the next meeting
- 5. The team spent time during governance reviewing the draft Facility Naming and Renaming policy. Edits were made during the meeting. The team completed edits, in order to bring forth for a first reading during the September 21, 2020 board meeting

- 6. A discussion was held to set up a meeting regarding chronic Illnesses. Ms. Jackson would help to facilitate the meeting to help address concerns around homebound for students with chronic illnesses
- 7. Today there was a conversation about the Code of Conduct in that there continues to be a need for follow up with staff and professional development in order to address social emotional learning needs in a restorative manner
- 8. The discussion around opt out policy centered on whether or not we have a practice-there is no current Opt out Policy per se.
- 9. Internet Safety Policy Revision was discussed specifically around the use of video recording during synchronous learning. There was a discussion around protecting the safety of students while also limiting the time for recording and if we are to record, making sure that the focus is on the teacher.
- 10. Mr. Goldson discussed the need to post policies online prior to meeting. We discussed having the DELT to present the equity policy on October 5, 2020.
